

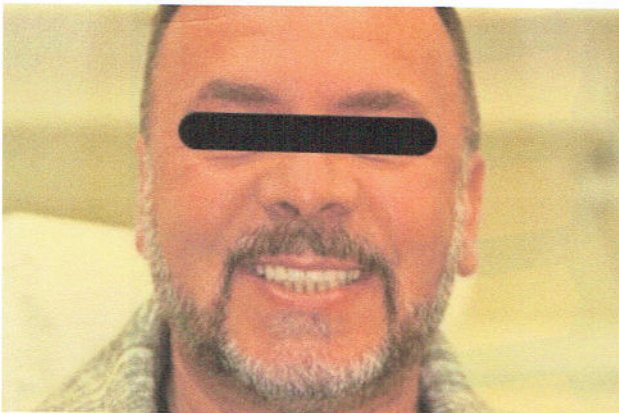
Dear Colleagues,

Newsletter Summary:

1. Chewing ability is one of most important factors in nutritional status and quality of life.
2. Quality of life can be improved by extending shortened dental arches with removable prosthetics.
3. Fixed implant supported prostheses are perceived better even before treatment is completed.
4. Conventional fixed, removable and implant Prosthodontics all improve quality of life. Surprisingly, after two years conventional removable Prosthodontics can show the greatest improvement. Obviously, this depends on many factors.

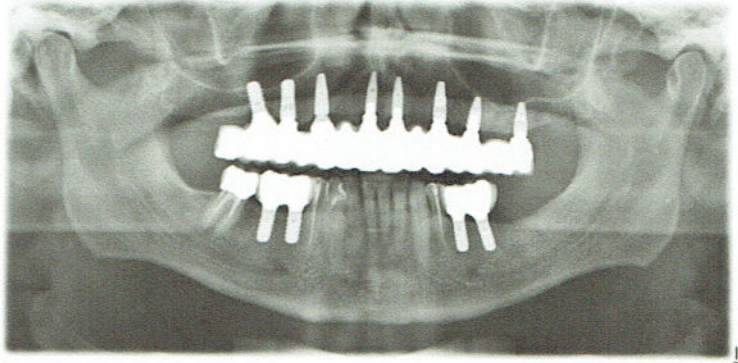
